## **ANAC and The Italian Regulatory Authority for Energy and Water signed the MoU for public contracts, transparency and anti-corruption**

Rome, 21 November 2016 – The presidents of the National Anti-Corruption Authority (ANAC), Raffaele Cantone, and the Regulatory Authority for Electricity Gas and Water (AEEGSI), Guido Bortoni, signed a Memorandum of Understanding today for the proper implementation and enforcement of legislation for public contracts, transparency and anti-corruption in the sectors regulated by the Authority for Energy, as well as for the application of possible extraordinary anti-corruption and anti-mafia measures in the management, support and monitoring of the companies operating in said regulated sectors.

The two Authorities will start their cooperation with exchange of opinions and alerts, and will collaborate sharing investigations and common actions. Through the memorandum, the two institutions will be able to report to each other cases when, during their regular course of business, occur that are of interest to the other Authority, and will also collaborate in sending reports to the Parliament or Government. Lastly, the agreement will allow the Authority for Energy to access the national database of public contracts in order to acquire information for preliminary enquiries in progress or to be started.
