## Gas: bill at +12% for consumption in October

ARERA communicates the value of the commodity: € 43.73/MWh, expenditure in the rolling year at -14.4%

## Milan, 3 November 2023 - The gas bill for the typical household<sup>1</sup> in standard offer for consumption in October 2023 has increased, rising by 12% compared to September.

The gas price component covering procurement costs ( $C_{MEM,m}$ ), applied to customers still under protection, is updated by ARERA as a monthly average of the price on the Italian wholesale market (the PSV day ahead) and published within the first 2 working days of the month following the reference month. For the month of October, which recorded a significantly higher average wholesale price than that of September, the price of the commodity gas alone ( $C_{MEM,m}$ ), for customers with protection contracts, was  $\notin$  43.73/MWh\*.

The overall increase of 12% for the typical household for the month of October is determined by the **increase in expenditure for natural gas**, +7.9%, and by the **increase in expenditure for transmission and meter management**, +4.1%, the latter related to the typical winter season increase in storage charges to ensure the full functionality of storage facilities during the period of highest use. By contrast, **general charges remain unchanged**.

In terms of final effects, the **gas expenditure for the typical household in the rolling year** (November 2022 - October 2023) is approximately € 1,457 before tax, down 14.4% compared to the equivalent 12 months of the previous year (November 2021 - October 2022).

The zeroing of general charges and the 5% VAT reduction has been confirmed for October and for the whole of 2023, as well as for heat management and district heating.
