

## **Gas: Arera publishes the commodity price for the Vulnerability Protection Service for April 2026** (-7.6% compared with March)

Milan, 5 May 2026 – Arera publishes the **commodity price** for gas under the Vulnerability Protection Service for April 2026.

The gas price component covering procurement costs ( $C_{MEM,m}$ ), **applied only to customers under the vulnerability protection service**, is updated by ARERA as the monthly average of the price on the Italian wholesale market (the VTP day-ahead) and published within the first two working days of the month following the reference period.

Following the increase recorded in March, wholesale prices fell significantly in April 2026, with the total bill for the typical customer decreasing by 7.6% compared with the previous month, while the  $C_{MEM}$  component alone fell by 11.7% compared with the March update. Accordingly, for the approximately 2.3 million customers still served under the Vulnerability Protection Service, the price of the gas commodity component alone ( $C_{MEM,m}$ ) amounts to **46.01 €/MWh**.

## UPDATE ON THE CONDITIONS OF THE GAS VULNERABILITY PROTECTION SERVICE FOR APRIL 2026

**NATURAL GAS** – For April 2026, the *reference gas price* for the new average customer <sup>1</sup> is 121.05 euro cents per cubic metre (-7.6% compared with March), broken down as follows:

### *Expenditure on the natural gas commodity:*

- 52.38 euro cents (equivalent to 43.27% of the total bill) for the supply of natural gas and related activities;
- 5.83 euro cents (4.82% of the total bill) for retail sale.

### *Expenditure on transport and meter management:*

- 24.19 euro cents (19.98% of the total bill) for distribution, metering, transport, distribution equalisation, and quality services.

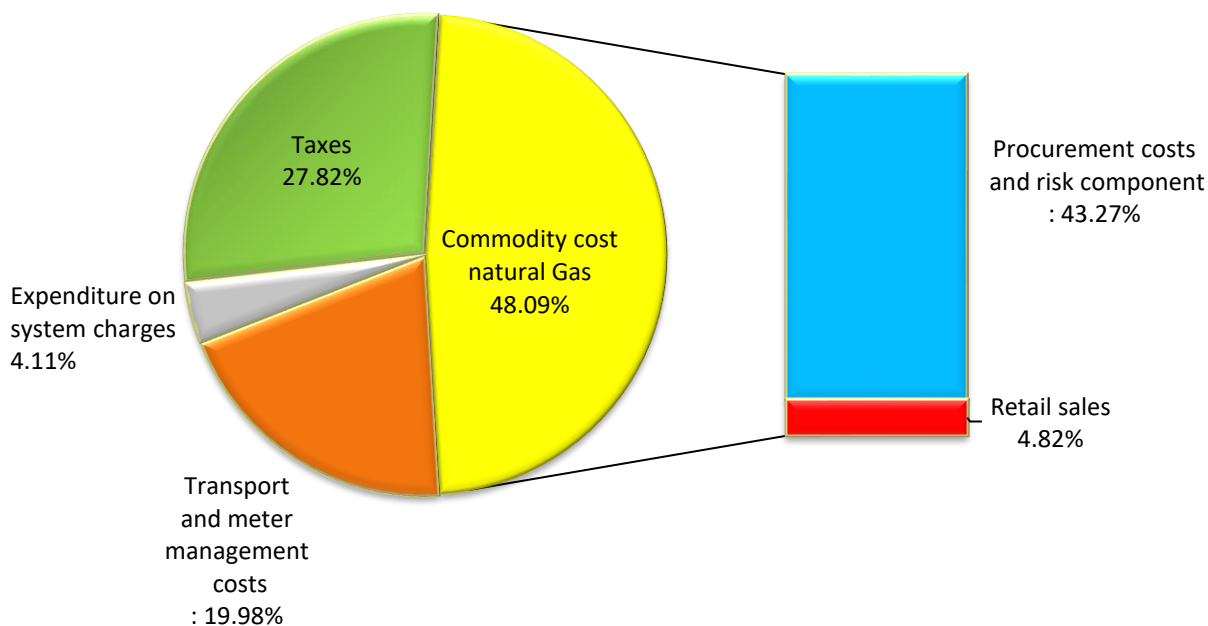
### *Expenditure on system charges:*

- 4.98 euro cents (4.11% of the total bill) for general charges.

### *Taxes:*

- 33.67 euro cents (27.82% of the total bill) for taxes.
