## **Energy: ARERA attends trilateral meeting with the heads of the Italian, French and German regulatory authorities**

Network tariffs and renewable generation among the key topics discussed

Milan, 19 June 2026 – ARERA Board Members Lorena De Marco and Francesca Salvemini, together with Secretary General Ilario Sorrentino, met yesterday in Paris with the President of the French Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE), Emmanuelle Wargon, accompanied by Commissioner Nadia Faure, and the President of Germany's Federal Network Agency (Bundesnetzagentur), Klaus Müller.

The meeting provided an opportunity both to share respective priorities and to address a number of challenges common to many European energy systems. Discussions focused on the role of regulators in managing periods when renewable generation significantly exceeds system demand, particularly in relation to the continued growth of solar generation, as well as on network tariff design in light of the expected developments in European legislation involving all national regulatory authorities.

In a rapidly changing European energy sector, dialogue among regulators plays an essential role in strengthening cooperation and identifying common responses to emerging regulatory challenges.
